Developments within the Period

a. In Turkey:

(1) Terrorist killed in Malatya where he came for bomb attack

The Malatya Intelligence and Anti-Terrorism teams launched an operation against a terrorist who came to the city to carry out bomb attack on June 2, 2016. He was killed by security forces after responding to 'surrender' call by shooting

(2) The Ministry of Interior has disclosed the figures of the fight against terrorism

According to the weekly reports published by Ministry of Interior about the operations within the country;

- 65 terrorists have been rendered ineffective between 19-28 June 2017,
- 51 terrorists have been rendered ineffective between 12-19 June 2017,
- 38 terrorists have been rendered ineffective between 5-12 June 2017,
- 48 terrorists have been rendered ineffective between 29 May- 5 June 2017.

(3) Curfew in Mardin and Bitlis

A curfew has been declared in some villages and neighborhoods of Dargeçit borough of Mardin and Hizan borough of Bitlis.

In the statement issued by the Governorship on June 07, 2017, it is stated that an operation will be carried out in order to neutralize the members of the separatist terrorist organization operating in Kerboran rural area

of Dargeçit borough and to find and destroy the shelters evaluated to be used by separatist terrorist organization.

(4) 42 terrorists have been rendered ineffective within one week

According to the weekly announcement made from General Staff on June 09, 2017, 42 terrorists have been rendered ineffective in the operations carried out in Şırnak, Hakkâri, Diyarbakır, Bingöl, Elazığ, Mardin, Hatay, Osmaniye and Gaziantep within one week.

(5) Air Operation Announcement from Turkish Armed Forces

According to the announcement made from TAF, in the operations carried out against the terrorist organisation within and out of the country, 16 terrorists including the ones followed in green and grey list have been rendered ineffective.

(6) Operations against DAESH Terrorist Organization

· Five ISIS terrorists were captured to cross to Kilis on Turkish-Syrian border on June 11, 2017.

· 18 suspects have been taken into the custody in the operation launched against the terrorist organization ISIS. Anti-Terrorism Branch Directorate Team have organized simultaneous operations to 19 adresses in 11 villages in order to arrest those who continue to carry out terrorist organization's activities in Istanbul. A great number of digital equipment, organizational publication, clamp, shutgun and 35 bullets are found in suspects' adresses.

· Abu Hanzala, code-named Halis Bayancuk, who was detained in Istanbul as a part of an investigation launched by the Sakarya Chief Public Prosecutor's Office over "attempting to remove the constitutional order and being a member of the armed terrorist group" was arrested and sent to prison.

Developments within the Period



a. In the World:

(1) Terror attack in London

A van hit pedestrians on London Bridge in central London on June 04, 2017.

The vehicle continued to drive to nearby Borough Market, where the suspects got out and stabbed several people in an area crowded with people.

It is reported that, seven people have been killed and three suspects shot dead by police after terror attack at London Bridge and Borough Market, and 48 patients taken to five hospitals.

A police officer who was responding to the attack on London Bridge was also stabbed.

Suspects wore hoax explosive vests, but they were fake, say police.

(2) Terror attack in Iran

It is reported that, gunmen and suicide bombers have attacked Iran's parliament in central Tehran and the Mausoleum of Ayatollah Khomeini in south of the city, killing at least 12 people and wounding 43 today in the morning.

Four armed assailants attacked parliament office buildings, while the shrine of revolutionary founder Ruhollah Khomeini was struck by a

suicide bomber, state media reported.

One of the attackers on Iran's parliament complex blew himself up amid an ongoing siege. ISIS issued a swift claim of responsibility.

(3) Blast in Brussel's train station

It is reported that a small explosion occurred in Brussels Central Station in Belgium on June 20, 2017.

The explosives belt on suicide bomber is detonated by security troops in a controlled way.

(4) Attack to hotel in capital of Philippines's capital Manila

An attack carried out to the hotel in Manila, capital of Philippines, on June 02, 2017. Security forces are directed to the hotel after gunshots and explosions heard from Resorts World Manila hotel close to Ninoy Aquino International Airport. At least 36 people lost their lives. It is reported that a man in mask fired to the visitors at the second floor of the hotel. A terrorist organization related to ISIS claimed the attack.

(5) Bomb attack to US Embassy in Kiev

Blast hit the premises of the US Embassy in Kiev, capital of Ukraine on June 08, 2017. Police reported that the explosion in the campus is caused by an explosive device thrown by an unknown person.

The Police Spokesperson identified the activity as "terror attack" on his social media account.

(6) Bomb attack to the mall in Colombia

3 people killed and 9 wounded in the explosion at the women's bathroom of a mall in Bogota, capital of Colombia.

It is reported after the investigation that the explosion is caused by bombed attack.

2 Cross-border Operations

a. Air operation to Northern Iraq

7 terrorists belonging to the separatist terrorist organization and in preparation of an attack towards the military bases on borderline have been rendered ineffective in the air operation carried out by Turkish Armed Forces in Avasin-Basian regions in the north of Iraq on June 28, 2017.

b. Air operation to Northern Iraq

An air operation has been launched by Turkish Armed Forces to Zap and Gara regions in northern Iraq on June 19, 2017. In the announcement made from TAF, it has been stated that two terrorists, who were detected by reconnaissance and surveillance devices, to be in preparation of an attack towards the operating units, have been rendered ineffective after the air operation and 3 caves and a weapon emplacement used by terrorists for quartering have been destroyed.

Security Assessment

It has been assessed that,

The PKK terrorist organization may continue its attacks towards the police and military units in the scope of ongoing operations carried out against the terrorist organizations especially in Eastern and Southeastern Anatolia Region,

The terrorist organizations, particularly PKK and ISIS, may carry out attacks in the form of armed, bomb or driving into crowds against soft targets such as malls, airports, terminals, performance centers, where people are together, in the way of attracting the attention of the international public opinion,

Within the scope of the "justice march" organized by the Republican People's Party, participation may grow as they approach to Istanbul where the march will end, and provocations may be carried out against the activity.

In this context, it is considered that the security sensitivity will also continue in the coming period.

Securitas Guidelines for Secure Life

In this section, we would like to inform you about the practical security measures to be taken when you go on travels.

Consideration of the points specified here will assist you in providing for your security during travels.

Measures to Take during Travels

As is known, people carry valuables including money, passports, etc. with them during travels. Therefore, individuals are also open to dangers during travels. Travellers are more vulnerable due to such frequent mishaps as losing the way in an unfamiliar environment while travelling through places which they don't know much in terms of their specific environment and security conditions.

What to Do:

- a. If the employees such as cleaner or driver come to your home during the travel, report the date and time of coming to security guard before going to travel.
- b. Before leaving for your travels, check the security rules/ practices of your destination.
- c. Before setting off, let some people know about your plans and leave them a number they can use to reach you. Inform the same people of any changes in your plans, as well.
- d. Take care in not carrying too many electronics or valuables with you on your travels.
- e. Keep your bag and luggage at a visible spot at all times during travels.
- f. Keep your passport, plane ticket, money and travellers' checks in a safe place. Have a belt bag produced specifically for these purposes under your clothing.
- g. Take two photocopies each of the identification and appearance page(s) and the visa page of your passport, your driver's license and the credit cards you will be carrying with you. Leave one copy of each of these documents at home and keep one copy of each with you, but in a space separate from your valuables.
- h. If possible, prefer direct flights. Minimise the time you will spend in non-secured public areas of airports. Enter the secure area without losing too much time at check-in and luggage procedures.

- i. Collect information on how you will reach your hotel or business meeting from the airport in advance. If you will be greeted by a person, obtain the exact identity information of that person.
- j. Stay at big and well-known hotels that are situated in the close vicinity of the centre or your destination point.
- k. At the hotel, prefer a room that is close to the lifts in order not to walk along long and empty corridors. If you feel restless, ask a hotel employee to accompany you to your room.
- l. Keep balcony doors and windows locked and the curtains closed while you remain in your room.
- m. Once you have reached your room, locate the closest fire exit. Walk towards the fire exit while also counting the number of rooms along the corridors. Visualise how you will make the distance in a dark and highly smoky environment. Read the fire instructions provided by the hotel.
- n. If you have a vehicle during your travels, park it in well-lit places.
- o. Use the exchange bureaus to convert your money. Be alert against people who may offer converting your money at the black market rate and against con men.
- p. Be vigilant against people who may ask you to accompany them to another spot by disguising as policemen or security personnel. Ask them to produce their ID and, if needed, call a local police station to verify their identity. You can also ask the reception at your hotel to help you in identifying such people. Before going with them, call the security guard and let them know about the situation.

What Not to Do:

- a. Answering the door and opening it without confirming any information the person behind the door may have provided. (In this situation, call the reception to double-check.)
- b. Entering the room upon finding the room open or unlocked. (In such cases, go to the reception and ask someone to accompany you to your room.)
- c. Staying on the ground floor or in rooms overlooking the external corridor. (If possible, book a room on an intermediary floor. The floor of the room must be high enough to prevent a person from breaking into your room easily and low enough for fire fighting equipment to reach.)
- d. Showing your room key to strangers.
- e. Keeping the "Please Clean the Room" tag on the door. (This tag shows that your room is vacant and calling the cleaners into your room will be a safer option than using this tag.)
